Guidelines for presentations

ORAL

1. Your talk is scheduled for 12 minutes plus 3 minutes for questions and discussion, in case of keynote lectures it is 25 minutes plus 5, respectively.
2. Only presentations using MS Powerpoint format (.ppt or .pptx) or Adobe PDF format (.pdf) can be displayed. If you use other programs, please convert your presentation to the appropriate format and test it in MS Windows environment.
3. To avoid compatibility problems and waste of time, only one stationary computer will be in use in the lecture hall. Please do not try to use your own computer/tablet for your presentation.
4. For any questions or nonstandard requirements connected with your presentation please contact us by e-mail.

POSTER

1. Each poster session consists of plenary presentation followed by personal discussion beside your poster. To make the poster session effective, the plenary presentation will be constructed by the organizers from earlier delivered individual slides.
2. Your poster talk is scheduled as a two-slide presentation (.ppt or .pdf format) with maximum one minute of speaking time. The first slide including author's name and affiliation as well as poster title, will be prepared by the organizers on the basis of the submitted abstract. The second slide with essential results/conclusion will be prepared by the author or authors.
3. Please send us this slide via e-mail **not later than 15 July 2016**.

4. There will be two poster sessions (Tuesday and Thursday). Each poster is assigned to one of these sessions. You may put posters on display as early as Sunday registration, 24 July. Posters have to be removed no later than on Friday 29 July, 15:00.
5. The poster maximum size is A0 portrait (width x height = 84 cm x 119 cm).

Conference Proceeding Book

The organizers are planning to include the submitted abstracts in the conference proceedings book. There is an opportunity to replace the existing abstract with an extended abstract, up to 4 pages large, which should be completed before **30 June 2016**.

Guidelines for the preparation of the extended abstracts - Proceeding Book

1. The maximum number of pages is four. This includes text, figures, tables and references prepared in the camera-ready form.
2. Please, download and use the enclosed template for a structured abstract preparation. Respect its internal structure, style and format.
3. Figures, tables and pictures must be of a good printable quality.
4. The extended abstract must be submitted electronically, preferably as a PDF document.

Name your abstract file using the corresponding author surname, followed by a digit if there is more than one abstract, e.g. *abstract-sobik1.pdf*, *abstract-sobik2.pdf*, etc.
